



# Just One More Ministries

July 2013 began my journey as a missionary to spread the gospel when I traveled with International Commission to Iloilo City, Philippines. This is where 26 Americans teamed up with 29 Filipino Pastors and walked the streets of Iloilo City and shared the gospel with men, women & children. We also preached at Molo Blvd Christian Fellowship and a house in Pavia where we witnessed many lives restored, many rededications, and also an unbelievable harvest of souls by our Almighty God. It was during my time in Iloilo City that I met Pastor Joe Iguales and his family. I fell in love with them and the Filipino people and returned home with a burden to somehow serve with Pastor Joe and help his people.

Just One More Ministries was formed in 2014 as my wife, Debra and I prayed for God to use us in the Philippines. God opened the doors for Just One More Ministries to sponsor "Chip in for a Cause" which was a Golf tournament that raised \$3,100 to build a church in Iloilo City.

In July of that year, I was able to travel and minister with Rock The World Ministries in Cedar City, UT at Henry's Place, a camp which is being built to serve inner city youth from the Las Vegas area. It will be a place of healing and growth for many troubled teens around the area. While preparing the ground site for the new camp, God gave us many opportunities to minister and share the gospel with the community and workers and we saw his hand in many salvations.

Debra and I had the opportunity to travel with Rock The World Ministries to the Dominican Republic in November. We participated in a Pastor's and laymen conference, a ladies conference and VBS. We completed minor construction and painting in a church in the morning and conferences and VBS were held simultaneously in the evening. We saw many people give their lives to Christ on this trip and they were from all walks of life, executives to junkyard workers. We also helped plant a church at Convento which is a small town in the mountains where we were able to share the gospel and pray with many on the streets.

The year 2015 started out with a bang as I traveled again with Rock the World Ministries and a great brother in Christ, John DeHoff, around the world to Iloilo City, Philippines. Literally around the world as we were almost iced and snowed in at the New York airport. We waited for hours to board a plane and finally were routed to the Philippines, but not without doing what God called us to do along the way. We saw God work mightily and save many souls in the airport terminal of New York, and as we arrived in each of the terminals in England, Amsterdam, Tapae, Taiwan before arriving at our final destination in the Philippines. While in Iloilo City, Philippines, we had opportunities to pray and minister to the people on the streets of the city. We were able to visit in homes, in private schools and several churches and saw God's great and mighty power as He drew the harvest of many souls during those two weeks.

As we headed home, the Filipino people were working together building their church with the help of the funds from the Golf Tournament. One third of the walls were complete before we landed in the U.S.A.

Our son, Josh traveled with Rock The World Ministries in March to Cowboy's Rest, a summer camp for children to help prepare for the 2015 season. There was much work done that week but two of the main jobs were in the maintenance of the heavy equipment & putting a metal roof on the chapel. They traveled to Reno, NV from there and then to Cedar City, UT and were given many opportunities along the way to share the gospel. They were able to make equipment repairs and maintenance while ministering in Cedar City.

I traveled in August 2015 to Kan Revelasyon in Pigion Haiti where I worked a youth camp. We preached in the morning and had small group sessions throughout the day along with arts & crafts. A worship service with over 200 Haitian in attendance was held each night. There were many salvations that week and many new friendships formed.

In March of this year we returned to Iloilo City and dedicated the new church for God's Glory! We saw God's mighty saving power work in the hotel staff, church members, public schools and on the streets. We preached in various churches in the city and worked with Pastor David in Oton, Pastor Joe Iguales' brother. A young ladies bible study was started and a seminary for 2017.
